After having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the counsel for the BISCOMAUN and having perused the stand taken in the show-cause coupled with the fact that the petitioners have already been paid their retiral dues, but payment of outstanding salary still remains, no modification as such to my Order, dated 05.01.2011 is required, because there is an assurance still by the BISCOMAUN that after meeting the obligation of retired employees, depending on the resources they shall take steps for payment of outstanding dues, which runs into crores of rupees for thousands of employees.

In the totality, therefore, application for modification of the Order for a categorical direction is uncalled for.

Petition is dismissed.
