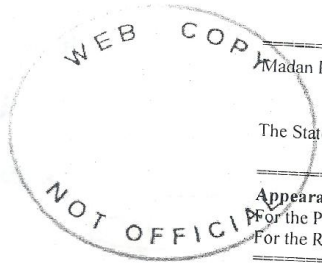

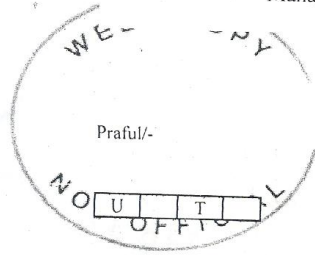
On 28/7/2014 Mr. Parthsarthy, learned counsel had submitted that he has received Vakalatnama on behalf of BISCOMAUN and the case was adjourned. Today Sri Ishwari Singh, learned counsel, has appeared and he submits that now Managing Director has changed and he has been authorized to appear in this case on behalf of BISCOMAUN.
